Saksham Community Centre serves a semi urban community of about 2,50,000 residents of Azadnagar, Manpada, Manoramanagar, Kolshet, Brahmand, Turbhepada, Dharamachapada and Patlipada Thane. It provides Dental services, specialist doctors consulting including eye, skin, Orthopedic, medical and homeopathic services at highly subsidised rates. Science, Maths & English for 5th to 10th Std., computer classes (MS Office, Tally), Coding, English speaking, hands on science, Commerce & Chess are conducted. Ladies are taught tailoring daily to help them become independent.

Dental Services




Successfully provided Dental treatment to 748 patients including 1 Dental Implant & 1 orthodontic case.

Chess Classes




To improve focus & attention, we conduct chess classes for about 30 students once a week (online & offline)

The Saksham Community Centre offers a wide range of services, including medical facilities like dental clinic, specialist doctor consultations (Eye, Skin, Orthopedic, Medical, ENT), a fully equipped eye clinic, homeopathic consultations (at highly subsidised rates), educational facilities (library, science lab, computer lab, digital education, and soft skills development mostly free), as well as livelihoods for women (tailoring at highly subsidised rates).

Saksham is a grassroots revolution that has consistently empowered the society around us with great care and compassion, and without losing sight of commercial viability and self-sustainability. It gives us great pleasure to share that Saksham has already had a positive impact on over 14000+ patients (on-site healthcare), 4000+ children (education) and 700+women (skill development); 6000+ children and adults (health camps)".
